HAVEYOUTAKENTHESE 4 STEPS?


Then you must:

- 3. Fellowship with other believers in the Church so that you can be cared for and grow up spiritually. - Hebrews 10:25.
- 4. Yield your life to God, Witness for Christ and bring others to Him - Mark 1:17.









A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom, and to return. And he called his ten servants, and delivered to them ten pounds, and said trade with these till I come. But his citizens hated him with passion and sent a message after him saying, we will not have this man to reign over us.

And it came to pass, that when he returned, having received the kingdom, he called these servants, to whom he had given the money, that he might know how much every man had gained by trading. (Luke 19:12-27). This parable illustrate the life of a nobleman who lent a pound each to his ten servants to trade. They were expected to give account on how the money was used. It is as God has lent each of us only one life to be spent according to His divine purpose.

He is the owner of every soul and expects everyone to live to please and serve Him. He said "Behold, all souls are mine...... the soul that sinneth, it shall die" (Ezekiel 18:4). Our souls are God's property. Therefore, no one has the right to live, speak or behave to satisfy his carnal nature or to serve the devil.

But it is a pity that people today live as though they were the author of their own lives. Their attitude to God is expressed they were the author of their own lives. Their attitude to God is expressed in the words of the wicked citizens. "We will not have this man to reign over us" (Luke 19:14). They will be examined whether their lives were profitable and productive to God or wretched and wasted in unrighteousness.

In view of this, so many individuals will be thrown into the lake of fire. God is not going to take it lightly with anyone who spends his life in sin and evil. As an individual, you will give account on how you spent every second, minute and day of your life. You will give account of every word you spoke, every imagination of your heart and every behaviour or habit in your life. You will be questioned on how you use your eyes, mouth, legs, hands e.t.c either as instruments of righteousness or unrighteousness.

Remember the prodigal son who wasted his life in riotous living was reconciled to his father, and his life took a positive turn, it was renewed and completely transformed (Luke 15:11-24). Likewise, there is remedy for you through Jesus Christ. He died for you on the cross of Calvary to take away your burden of sin and make your life meaningful. The door of mercy is widely open today. He knocks at your heart and seek admission. And he will change your life the moment you confess, forsake your sins and make Him your personal Lord and Saviour.

Remember, your life is borrowed. It is not yours and you have an account to give which will determine whether you will be lost or eternally saved. So, you have no choice than to reconcile with God through Jesus Christ in genuine repentance and faith. And afterwards, commit yourself to living by the principles of godliness everyday of your life.
